

CHECKLIST

FOR THE PREPARATION OF A SEPARATION AGREEMENT

Do you intend to separate from your spouse? Or have you already taken this step and moved out of the shared residence?

How long should the separation last? Is there a prospect of reunification? Have you clarified your professional situation?

The following points, among others, are to be settled when separating:

Assignment of the family home

- Who stays in the home and has the exclusive right to use it?
- Who is moving out and when?
- Do you agree on this?
- If not, the court will decide. The criterion will be who is better served by the home

Allocation of household items and furniture temporarily during the period of separation

- Attention: the provisional allocation made at the time of separation will often anticipate the definitive allocation.
- Do you agree on this?
- If not, who does the furniture serve more?

- A written agreement alone is insufficient.
- With the ruling on property division, the effective date for the division of marital property is fixed.
